## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### ALL CAMP AND CONFERENCE CENTERS

1. **NO food, drink, or gum allowed in the meeting area or during the cabin times!**
2. **The Conference Schedule must be followed by everyone.**
3. Attendance at all meetings (including cabin times and morning revival) is mandatory. In case of sickness, appropriate medical attention will be obtained and parents may be asked to come take the sick child home.
4. During cabin times, everyone will be encouraged to participate.
5. Respect the camp staff. If you have a problem, tell your serving one who will tell the coordinating brothers. **DO NOT** go to the camp staff directly.
6. Take care of the campgrounds. Pick up any paper, soda cans, or trash you see on the ground.
7. No one may leave the campgrounds at any time.
8. Serving ones are permitted to rise before the scheduled rising time as long as they do not waken others.
9. Take short showers!
10. There must **not be any excessive noise** or shouting outdoors early in the morning or after the evening meeting in order not to disturb the neighbors.
11. **NO ELECTRONIC ITEMS ARE ALLOWED (RADIOS, TVs, CASSETTE PLAYERS, CD PLAYERS, PDAs, CELL PHONES, ETC.).**
12. No novels or magazines are allowed other than spiritual reading materials.
13. Hiking is permitted on designated trails only.
14. Lights out at scheduled time! That means no talking, and no leaving the cabin during the night.
15. All clothing worn during the entire weekend must be proper and modest. No shorts may be worn during the meetings. **No open toe shoes. No clothing, caps, or shirts with improper pictures, logos, or symbols may be worn.**
16. Additional rules may be added during the conference.
17. The serving ones are responsible to see that the young people from their locality follow these instructions.
